TWINNING PROFILE

Background: The history of this Twinning goes back to the European Ranger Congress 2017 in Litoměřice, Czech Republic, where it was signed. The idea for the cooperation between the **Croatian rangers** and the Portuguese ranger association **Associação Portuguesa de Guardas e Vigilantes da Natureza** was born 2014 in Brijuni National Park, Croatia, while Portuguese rangers were visiting.

Main Topics

- Management of protected nature areas
- Exchange of work experience between rangers
- Maintenance work in protected areas
- Fire and emergency services
- Monitoring of plant and animal species
- Supervision in the field



- **Practical Exchange Program:** about 5 rangers from Portugal/Croatia carry out practical work for 10 to 15 days in around 3 protected areas in the partner's country; in addition, the visitors give a presentation about their home protected areas
- Knowledge & Practical Experience Exchange Program: exchange of lecturers who give thematic presentations about park management systems on their national level or on a particular protected area and species management.



- **mutual visits** within the framework of the programs described above; food, transport and accommodation (camping and mountain huts) are provided by the host
- **visits to the annual conferences** of the twinning partner by individuales or groups
- exchange on digital platforms and social networks

- 2014: The idea for cooperation between Croatian and Portuguese rangers was born at 3rd European Ranger Congress in Brijuni, Croatia.
- 2017: First meeting of both country's rangers at ERC in Litoměřice and signing of the Twinning agreement
- Several exchanges of national ranger delegations followed, usually as mutual visits for the national annual seminars
- Delegations of Croatian rangers visited Portugal, during which they learned about the management of protected parts of nature in the region of Lisboa, Sintra, Azores, Madeira and Algarve
- Delegations of Portuguese rangers visited Croatia and exchanged experiences with Croatian rangers in NP Krka, NP Paklenica, City of Zagreb, NP Plitvička jezera, NP Velebit, PP Žumberak Samoborsko gorje, NP Brijuni
- 2022: Presentation at the European Ranger Congress, Albania, on the development of the Twinning project to European colleagues
