Background: The twinning agreement between the Danish ranger association **Naturvejleder** and the Finnish **Suomen Rangerit** association was concluded in 2017 at the European Ranger Congress in Czechia. The **partnership between the two Nordic countries** was a natural choice, as Ranger Twinnigs can involve ranger associations from either two different regions, but also from two similar regions to allow for **deeper exchanges on common issues**.
