The Dartmoor Transparency Concept

1. Guidelines

In accordance with the fundraising principles adopted by the Executive Committee (EEC) of the European Ranger Federation (ERF), there are clear guidelines for acquiring funds (financing personnel costs and projects). To ensure compliance with the principles and to advise the board, the board appoints a committee of experienced persons of previous EEC members.

2. ERF-Council – Status 2023

The EEC established an advisory group as ERF-Council. The ERF-Council currently is composed of the following persons:

- Urs Wegmann, Switzerland, former President ERF

By the end of February of each year, a brief report on ERF's fundraising activities from the previous year is sent to the ERF member organisations and to the ERF-Council for review. At the same time, the Council receives a short overview of the planned activities of the current year, as far as they are known by then. In addition, an online-meeting to check open questions, etc. can be arranged.

At the General Assembly of the ERF, the Financial Officer - besides the finance report and budget planning - also gives an overview of the fundraising activities. General assemblies also can be used for a further development of fundraising principles and transparency goals on a common ground with the ERF members.



National member organisations are encouraged to a gradual adoption of the fundraising activities, the fundraising principles and the transparency procedure developed by the EEC. The goal should be to successfully present the sovereignty and seriousness of all participating partner organisations to the publicity.
