It's highly motivating for me not to have two similar days in one week. One day is bison day, the other I go with the police to the field looking for poachers, and on the third day I visit school classes to connect them with nature.

The best moments are when I see very rare birds nesting, such as the black stork. There was a nest that I had been searching for years. When I found it and waited for hours, the sun was already setting, the stork
